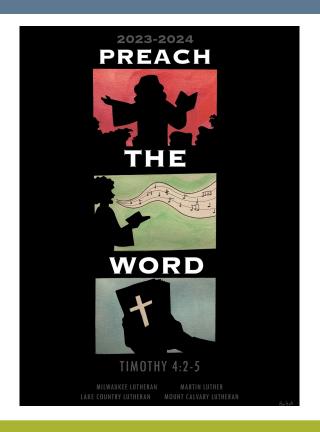
Focus on the Word: Cole Braun, CEO

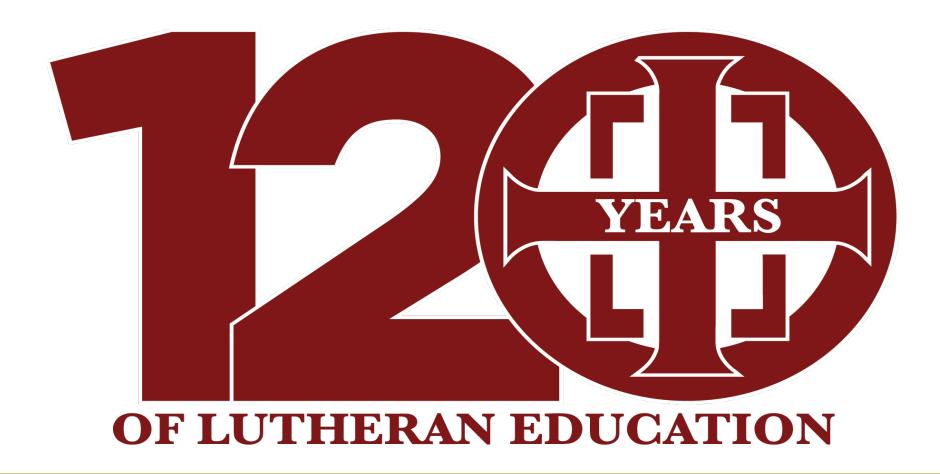

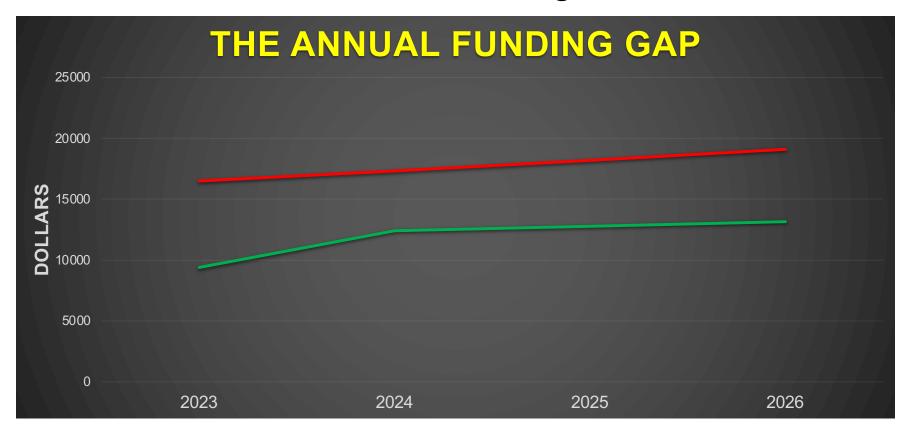
